Thank you for your inquiry regarding educational assistance by way of Owen Connolly Estate Bursary. This year all applications must be submitted on-line using the application form available on this website.

The Estate may provide a bursary to applicants who meet the following criteria:

- (1) Irish in heritage (as defined by Supreme Court of PEI)
- (2) Poor (demonstrated financial need);
- (2) Resident of Prince Edward Island;
- (3) Members of the Roman Catholic Church;
- (4) Enrolled full-time in an undergraduate program at an accredited university

 Note- college students who are completing a joint program/ degree with a university may qualify during the years that they are attending the university portion of their studies.

Connolly Estate Bursaries are available for a maximum of four years. Recent bursaries have been in the range of \$2000 per year, though future awards may differ depending on market returns and the number of applicants.

The application form collects the information needed by the Trustees to adjudicate an applicant's eligibility according to the above criteria. The Trustees, guided by an interpretation of a Justice of the Supreme Court of Prince Edward Island, have reviewed the objects and qualifications as identified in Mr. Connolly's Last Will and Testament. This bursary is open to both male and female applicants. We are hopeful that, in keeping with the original intent of the Will, this bursary provides a meaningful financial contribution towards the attainment of a university education. While the other three factors are important for adjudication, a primary emphasis shall be on the poor (need) factor.
